Students return to their club with enthusiasm, new contacts, fresh ideas, an increased understanding of their potential as Rotarians, and valuable skills impacting their potential leadership in the club. Registration is quick and simple and you may register on-line.

The sessions are \$85.00 each with a discount mentioned in the next paragraph.
